2	Speech-Language Pathology and Audiologist	<p>a. Perform audio logical assessments and advice on hearing aids depending upon the severity of the child. He/she has to refer to the institutes where such aids are available.</p> <p>b. Guide and counsel the parents about the auditory training.</p> <p>c. Assess the level of receptive and expressive language</p> <p>d. Formulate treatment goals on the basis of needs of the child.</p> <p>e. Explain the parents and/ or caregivers the importance of speech therapy and demonstrate therapy to them so that they can carry out therapy at home in all the daily living activities.</p> <p>f. Maintain records of the follow-up of the child, note progress and doing reassessments wherever deemed necessary and at periodic intervals. The reports of the progress of the child and achievement of goals must be conveyed to the parents.</p> <p>g. Assess for speech disorders</p> <p>h. Work as a part of the DEIC team and liaison with other team members in formulating a comprehensive and inclusive programme for the holistic approach</p> <p>i. Provide services that focus on verbal and non-verbal communication skill development</p> <p>j. Assess the oro- motor skills required for feeding problems (sucking and swallowing) for the children with Neuro-motor impairment.</p> <p>k. Facilitate speech clarity (ability to produce and combine speech sounds and use the voice), facial expression, body language and gestures, alternative or augmentative communication (e.g., sign language, picture symbols and verbal output devices, PECT), pre-literacy skills.</p> <p>l. Ensure functionality of equipment/toys/furniture.</p>
